

4.9 Addendum A – Criteria for Enrollment

The Virtual School is not an “at-risk” educational program for students who are credit deficient or find themselves unsuccessful in the traditional educational setting. However, “at-risk” students may enroll provided they meet enrollment criteria. We have other programs to address credit recovery and “at-risk” students.

Students who are considered for entrance into the Virtual School shall meet, or exceed, the following criteria to be considered for admittance:

- Have a parent or guardian who is actively involved in the student’s virtual learning activities
- Be self-motivated and self-disciplined
- Be a good time manager
- Be proficient with email and word processing software
- Be able to read and analyze text
- Be able to set and achieve goals
- Be confident in their academic abilities
- Show determination when confronting obstacles
- Be personally invested in their own education
- Avoid conflicts with activities that may interfere with learning
- Have convenient and frequent access to a computer and the Internet
- Be willing to try new learning formats and activities
- Be able to work with little supervision
- Be computer literate
- Have maintained a positive record of attendance
