We are excited to announce that we have an afterschool program in every community in the district this year. Programs in Lewisburg and Cornersville are funded by 21st Century Community Learning Center grants and the program in Chapel Hill is funded by a Lottery for Education Afterschool Program. The annual amount of the grants is \$469,852.26. This allows us to serve approximately 375 children each day at no cost to the family.

The program is offered daily at Oak Grove Elementary School, Marshall Elementary School, Westhills Elementary School, Cornersville Elementary School and Delk-Henson Intermediate School.

Participants in the program receive a healthy snack daily, homework and academic assistance as well as an enrichment activity.
